





BACKGROUND

The Association of Ghana Industries as part of its mission to create a supportive and competitive business climate, which will make Ghanaian businesses locally and internationally competitive, has been organizing the Ghana Industrial Summit & Exhibition annually since 2017. The GISE has been hosted with support from the Ministry of Trade & Industry, Ministry of Foreign Affairs, and reputable local industries.

The GISE is designed to assemble captains of industry, policy makers, international industrialists, and entrepreneurs on one platform to discuss pertinent issues confronting industry and cutting edge solutions to propel industry forward.

The Summit has always centered around five objectives.


- create an annual global platform for industrialists to share ideas on innovation and technology with the aim of enhancing industrialization.
- establish and encourage networking between indigenous industrialists and their international counterparts for knowledge sharing and exchange of best practices in industry.
- engage key government agencies driving the economy in constructive dialogue in search of viable solutions to challenges facing industry.
- bring all sectors of the economy together to chart a common course towards industrial advancements for the benefit of the local economy.
- create opportunities between sellers and buyers to enhance business activities for economic gains through match-making programmes and exhibitions.

This year's forum will intensify Ghana's Investment Promotion efforts and the estimated potential in the Agriculture and Agro-processing, ICT and FinTech, Financial Services, Mining and mineral processing, Oil and Gas, Energy and Renewable Energy, and Services sectors.

The Summit's main goal is to promote investing in Ghanaian businesses to investors and investor intermediary audiences. 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CONTEXT

The purpose of the Investment Summit is to promote investing in Ghanaian businesses to investor and investor intermediary audiences. Attracting foreign direct investment (FDI) is a tough venture, but that is one of the few ways of getting an economy invigorated for growth. The opportunity to explore local funding opportunities from individuals and institutions with surplus funding is mostly ignored by businesses, as the fixation on attracting FDI continues. This Investment Summit shall create a platform for businesses to introduce their ventures to local investors and receive offers.

While the prospects for companies in the agribusiness and agroprocessing sectors are huge, investments in these sectors seem to have stalled due to lack of investor interest. This might have resulted from the lack of understanding of the investment climate in the country and most importantly the infrastructure needed to make investments attractive to investors. According to Jeffrey Sachs in an article, "Investors will invariably require electricity, water, physical security, basic public health facilities, and access to airports, ports, and telecoms. Administrative services such as port clearance and predictable tax administration are also essential". In Ghana and "administration becomes an additional factor critical for investors, especially when it comes to agriculture and the setting up of factories".

It is important to bring all stakeholders together to have a thorough discussion on the investment climate in Ghana with the objective of increasing foreign direct investments in the agribusiness, agroprocessing and general manufacturing sectors. The need for investors to be taken through all the sectors primed for investments, the business community positioning themselves to take advantage of such investments from impact investors and fostering a long-term relationship between these key actors to drive investments in Ghana.

It is envisaged that investors would take advantage of all the investment opportunities that exist in the Ghanaian economy to take advantage of the single African Market as created by the AfCFTA for industrial growth; and good returns on their investment.
