

- Africa holds 40% of the world's renewable energy potential.
- Between 2019-2021, over 75% of \$4.5 billion in climate blended finance for Sub-Saharan Africa went to renewable energy.
- Africa's agricultural sector has the potential to transform into a \$1 trillion market by 2030.
- By 2030, 50% of Africans will be urban, rising to 65% by 2060.
- The Alliance for Green Infrastructure in Africa targets \$500 million for project development, aiming to generate \$10 billion for sustainable green initiatives.
