GENERAL PROCUREMENT NOTICE

1. The Federal Democratic Republic of Ethiopia has received a loan from the African Development Fund to finance the Climate Resilient Wheat Value Chain Development Project (CREW) - Ethiopia Project. The project is designed to be implemented for five years (2024-2028).
2. The principal objectives of this project are to improve wheat productivity and production thereby increasing the incomes of small-scale wheat farmers in Ethiopia. The Project component of the will be implemented in 76 Woredas (districts), in the Oromia, Amara, Afar, and Somali Regional States of Ethiopia. The Ministry of Agriculture (MoA) will be responsible for procurement activities under the project.
3. The Project consists of three components:
 - i. Climate Smart Wheat Productivity and Production;
 - ii. Market Infrastructure, Linkages, and Agri-Finance; and
 - iii. Project Coordination and Management.
4. Procurement of goods and/or works and acquisition of consultancy services will be carried out in accordance with the Procurement Policy for Bank-Funded Operations, dated October 2015. Bidding documents are expected to be available in April 2024.

The Procurement modes are as follow:

- **International Competitive Bidding (ICB):** Procurement of Consultancy service for Baseline Survey, Design and Supervision of works (including various studies – feasibility studies, environmental and social impact assessment, gender action plan), Technical Assistance for d or Identification of Possible seed pack sizes based on National Study to Develop rules and regulations and to support the new contract farming policy, Procurement of Goods, i.e. Different types of Agricultural Machineries and Equipment's (Tractors, Row planters, Combine Harvester, Seed Planters, Moldboard plows, Seed thresher, drill and Cleaners, Water pumps), Procurement of Vehicles and Motorcycles.

- **National Competitive Bidding (NCB):** i) Works Procurement; such as large warehouses, Seed Stores at the research stations and Mechanization Service Centres; Construction and Rehabilitation of irrigation schemes.

- **Shopping:** Office equipment: ICT and furniture; Stationaries and Office supplies.

- **Services- Firms by National Shortlist:** Financial Audit, Training and Technical assistance on the new contract farming rules and regulations for farmers, traders and millers/processors
