Egypt – AfDB Exploring Opportunities in Critical Industrial Sectors

The Government of Egypt's 2024–2027 Work-Plan emphasizes closer collaboration with the private sector to address pressing finance and developmental challenges. Building on this vision, the Ministry of Planning, Economic Development & International Cooperation (MoPEDIC) has launched a series of sector-based roundtables—titled B.R.I.D.G.E. (Business Roundtables for Innovation, Development, and Government Engagement)—in partnership with various global development finance institutions (DFIs). This involves bringing together multiple stakeholders representing government, businesses, and DFIs to discuss innovative partnership modalities, identify new investment opportunities, and implement projects that address critical challenges. Having previously partnered with other organizations, the 3rd Edition will be held in collaboration with the African Development Bank (AfDB), with the facilitation of the Egyptian Businessmen Association (EBA), and other esteemed business associations.

The AfDB's cumulative financing to Egypt reached USD 7.7 billion. Egypt has access to USD 500 million on an annual basis to finance sovereign and non-sovereign operations. In 2025, the Bank plans to invest USD 300 million in support of private sector operations through project finance, corporate finance, and lines of credit to help improve large corporations and SMEs' access to funding. The Bank targets five high priority areas (“the High 5s”) to accelerate the Bank's delivery for Africa, namely, Light up and Power Africa, Feed Africa, Industrialize Africa, Integrate Africa and Improve the quality of life for the people of Africa. Priority sectors include Pharmaceutical, Food Industries, Chemicals and Fertilizers, the Logistics and ICT sectors.

This roundtable will spotlight opportunities in Egypt's industrial sectors and explore ways to enhance private-sector-led growth.

The MoPEDIC and the AfDB will invite 40-50 Egyptian Manufacturers/Companies/SPVs/Projects to participate at this exclusive roundtable. The event will provide the opportunity for Egyptian companies to explore potential financing opportunities with AfDB between 2025 and 2027 and strengthen African linkages through exports or investments. The agenda will cover high-level presentation on Egypt's private sector orientations, collaboration opportunities and industrial investment targets between 2025 and 2027. In addition, high level presentations on AfDB's financing tools relevant to Egyptian critical sectors will be presented, followed by an open discussion.
