MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING 3/26

a duly established entity operating in accordance with the applicable laws,

represented by:

and

Egyptian African Businessmen's Association, entered into the National Court Register under number _____,

with its registered address at El Wazara Square, 1154 Omar Ebn EL Khatab St, Sheraton, Cairo, Egypt,

a duly established entity operating in accordance with the applicable laws,

represented by:

hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Parties" and individually as a "Party".

PREAMBULE

Considering that the Parties pursue activities aligned with their statutory or operational objectives;
Acknowledging the intention to establish a long-term and transparent cooperation founded on
partnership, equality, and mutual respect;
Desiring to establish an organisational framework for the effective implementation of joint initiatives;
the Parties hereby agree as follows:

§ 1

Nature of the Memorandum

1. This Memorandum of Understanding is intended as a framework and statement of intent.
2. This Memorandum does not create financial obligations unless expressly agreed by the Parties in separate written agreements.
3. This Memorandum defines the general principles of cooperation and coordination between the Parties.

§ 2

Objectives of Cooperation

The Parties agree that their cooperation shall aim, in particular, at:

- a) exchanging knowledge, experience, and information;
- b) supporting initiatives of mutual interest;
- c) developing projects to be implemented jointly or concurrently;
- d) fostering long-term institutional relations.

§ 3

Scope of Cooperation

The cooperation of the Parties may, in particular, include:

- a) joint planning and coordination of activities;
- b) preparation of analyses, research, and studies;
- c) organisation of events, meetings, seminars, or conferences;
- d) expert and advisory collaboration;
- e) informational and promotional activities.

1. The specific terms and conditions of individual initiatives shall be agreed upon separately in protocols, agreements, or arrangements.

§ 4

Principles of Cooperation

1. The Parties shall act in good faith and exercise due care in the performance of this Memorandum.
2. Each Party shall bear responsibility exclusively for its own activities.
3. This Memorandum shall not be construed as creating any relationship of subordination or a joint undertaking within the meaning of the law.

§ 5

Financing

1. Each Party shall bear its own expenses incurred in connection with the performance of this Memorandum, unless otherwise agreed by the Parties.
2. The terms governing the financing of joint initiatives may be specified in separate agreements.

§ 6

Confidentiality

1. The Parties undertake to keep confidential any information obtained in connection with this Memorandum that is designated as confidential or that should reasonably be regarded as confidential by its nature.
2. The confidentiality obligations shall survive the termination or expiration of this Memorandum.

§ 7

Intellectual Property Rights

1. Unless otherwise agreed by the Parties, the rights to any results arising from the cooperation shall vest in the Party that created them.
2. The use of materials belonging to the other Party shall require the prior written consent of that Party.

§ 8

Use of Name and Designations

Any use of the name, logo, or other identifying marks of the other Party shall require prior written approval.

§ 9

Term and Termination

1. This Memorandum of Understanding is entered into for an indefinite term.
2. Either Party may terminate this Memorandum upon 30 days' written notice to the other Party.
3. Such termination shall not affect any ongoing joint initiatives, which shall be governed by separate agreements between the Parties.

§ 10

Final Provisions

1. Any amendments to this Memorandum must be made in writing under pain of nullity.
2. This Memorandum represents the entire agreement of the Parties with respect to its subject matter.
3. The execution of separate implementing agreements shall not be deemed an amendment to this Memorandum.
4. This Memorandum is executed in two counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original.
5. In the event of inconsistencies between language versions, the Polish version shall be controlling.
