This Annex forms an integral part of the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) and sets out the detailed terms and conditions for the implementation of a specific activity, project, or form of cooperation between the Parties.

## § 1

### **Legal Status of the Annex**

1. This Annex serves as an implementing and detailing instrument to the MOU.
2. This Annex shall not be construed as creating an employment relationship, a partnership, or a joint undertaking within the meaning of Polish law.
3. To the extent not governed by this Annex, the provisions of the MOU and the applicable laws of the Republic of Poland, including the Civil Code, shall apply.

## § 2

### **Scope and Purpose of Cooperation**

1. This Annex governs the implementation of the following activity / project (the “Project”):

Polish-African Development Congress (short: PAKR, PADC), held in Lodz, Poland, on dates: 19-20.10.2026.

2. The objective of the Project is:

to jointly support the organization of the Polish–African Development Congress (PAKR), contributing to the advancement of diplomatic, economic, and institutional relations between Poland and African states.

3. The Project shall be implemented in alignment with the statutory objectives of the Parties.

## § 3

### **Scope of Cooperation**

1. Within the framework of the Project, the Parties undertake to cooperate, in particular, in the following areas:
  - a. promotion of the Polish–African Development Congress (PAKR) within their respective institutional and professional networks,
  - b. support for the visibility and outreach of the Project at the national and international level,
  - c. facilitation of contacts with potential participants, partners, and stakeholders relevant to the objectives of the Project,

- d. exchange of knowledge, expertise, and experience related to economic cooperation, international dialogue, and development initiatives,
2. Each Party shall act in its own name and under its own responsibility.

#### § 4

#### **Roles and Obligations of the Parties**

1. **Diplomacy and Business Foundation** shall, in particular, be responsible for:
  - a. overall organization, coordination, and implementation of the Polish–African Development Congress (PAKR),
  - b. development of the Congress program, agenda, and thematic structure,
  - c. ensuring appropriate visibility of EABA as a strategic partner, including placement of the Association’s logo on official event platforms and materials,
  - d. coordination of speakers, panels, and institutional participants,
  - e. confirmation of logistical arrangements for designated representatives of EABA, subject to separate written agreement or confirmation.
2. **Egyptian African Businessmen’s Association** shall, in particular, be responsible for:
  - a. supporting the promotion of the Polish–African Development Congress (PAKR) in Egypt and within its African business and institutional networks,
  - b. facilitating outreach to potential participants by extending invitations, on a best-effort basis, to selected companies and stakeholders, including up to ten (10) companies,
  - c. providing expert and substantive support, including participation of designated representatives as speakers or contributors,
  - d. sharing institutional knowledge and expertise relevant to African markets, economic cooperation, and business development.
3. Any delegation of rights, powers, or responsibilities shall require prior written consent.

#### § 5

#### **Speakers and Representation**

1. EABA designates:

- Dr. Yousrey El Sharkawi – Chairman of EABA
- Eng. Hussein El Ghazzawy – Head of the Energy Committee

as official representatives and speakers within the Project.

2. The Parties acknowledge that:
  - a. Dr. El Sharkawi shall deliver an official speech within the Congress program,
  - b. Eng. El Ghazzawy shall participate as a speaker in a thematic panel.
3. Final confirmation of participation and logistical arrangements shall be subject to mutual written confirmation.

## § 6

### **Implementation Schedule**

1. Commencement date of the Project: \_\_\_\_\_
2. Completion date of the Project: 31.10.2026
3. Key stages of implementation:
  - a. preparation phase, including program development and partner coordination;
  - b. promotion and outreach activities;
  - c. organizational and logistical arrangements;
  - d. implementation of the Polish–African Development Congress (PAKR);
  - e. post-event activities, including evaluation and follow-up.

## § 7

### **Financial Arrangements**

1. This Annex shall not give rise to any financial commitments of the Parties, unless expressly agreed in a separate written agreement.
2. Unless otherwise agreed in writing, each Party shall bear its own expenses incurred in connection with the Project.
3. Any agreed Project budget shall be attached hereto as an attachment to this Annex.

## **§ 8**

### **Reporting and Supervision**

1. The Parties shall maintain continuous communication concerning the progress of the Project.
2. At the request of an authorised Party, periodic reports may be produced, covering the activities undertaken, challenges encountered, and results achieved.

## **§ 9**

### **Confidentiality and Personal Data Protection**

1. Any confidential information obtained in the course of performing this Annex shall be subject to protection in accordance with the provisions of the MOU and Polish law.
2. Personal data shall be processed in accordance with applicable laws, including Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (GDPR) and national legislation.

## **§ 10**

### **Intellectual Property**

1. Unless otherwise agreed in writing, the proprietary copyrights to the results of the Project shall belong to the Party that created them.
2. The use of the other Party's name, marks, logos, or materials shall require prior written approval.

## **§ 11**

### **Responsibility and Liability**

1. Each Party shall bear responsibility exclusively for its own actions or failures to act, pursuant to the applicable provisions of the Civil Code.
2. The Parties hereby exclude liability for consequential damages, including loss of profits, unless such exclusion is not permitted under mandatory law.

## **§ 12**

### **Term and Termination**

1. This Annex becomes effective upon signature by both Parties.
2. It shall remain valid until the Project is completed or terminated pursuant to the MOU.
3. Any termination of the MOU shall automatically terminate this Annex.

### **§ 13**

#### **Applicable Law and Jurisdiction**

1. This Annex shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Republic of Poland.
2. The Parties shall endeavour to resolve any disputes amicably.
3. In the absence of an amicable settlement, disputes shall be resolved by the court of competent jurisdiction for the registered office of [Party A].

### **§ 14**

#### **Final Provisions**

1. Any modifications to this Annex must be made in writing under pain of nullity.
2. This Annex is executed in two counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original.
