

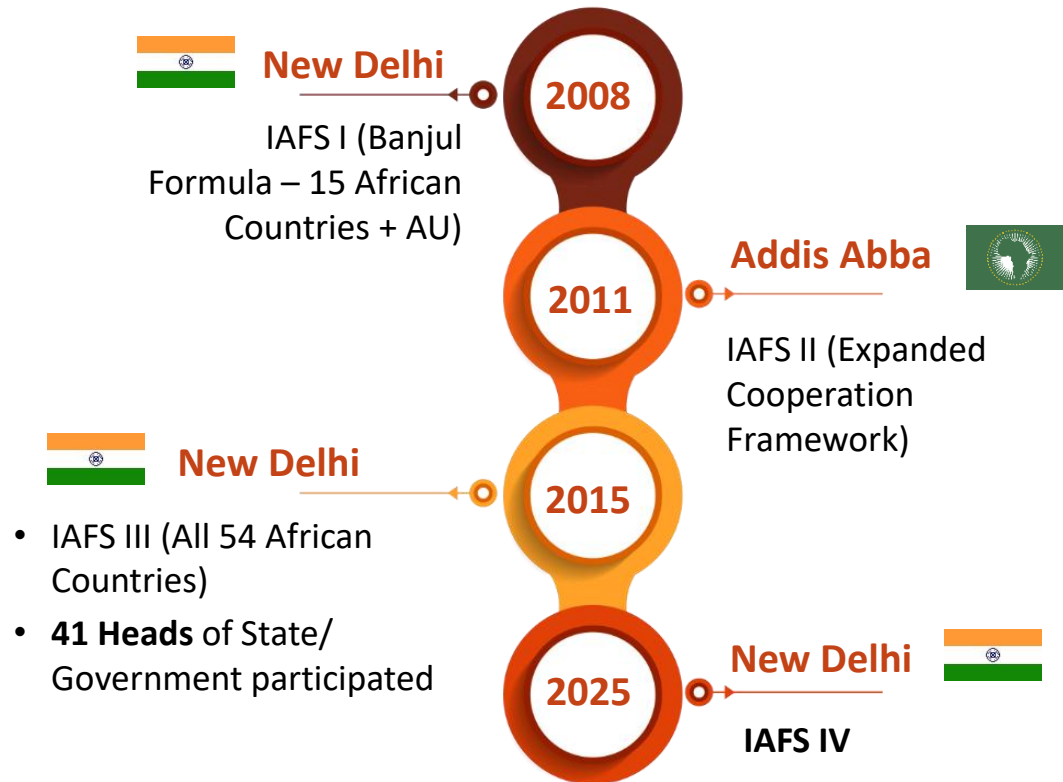

IAFS Timeline



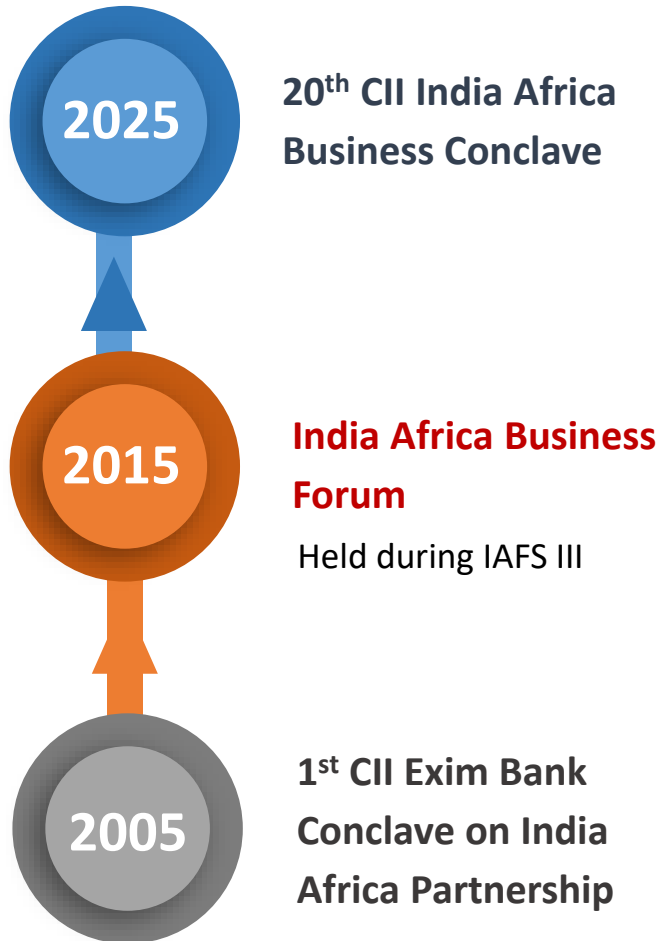
